

Texas Skills Development Fund

Administered by the Texas Workforce Commission, the Skills Development Fund is an excellent workforce training tool created to grant money to community colleges to conduct workforce training specific and tailored to local companies. The grant money must flow through local community colleges who in turn hire instructors to conduct on- or off-site training.

Through Blinn College, local companies have already received the benefits from a 15-month training curriculum on more than one occasion. The College is currently exploring more permanent certification and degree options within the workforce training venue.
